OCTOBER 2, 2021 SELF-GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS

For the attention of the voters!

Voting is held from 08:00 to 20:00!

Upon entering the polling place:

- Go through the electoral stain check procedure;
- Treat your hands with disinfectant liquid placed at the entrance;
- Submit your ID card or passport of a Georgian citizen, temporarily remove the facemask for identification.

At the registration desk:

- Submit your ID card or passport of a citizen of Georgia to the registrar and temporarily remove your facemask
- Undergo indelible ink marking procedure;
- Sign along your name on the voter list;
- Use a pen for individual use on the registrar desk to sign and when casting your ballot;
- Receive the sealed and signed ballots from the registrar.

You will not be allowed at the polling station:

- If you refuse to temporarily remove a facemask for identification when presenting your
 ID card or the passport of the citizen of Georgia;
- If it turns out that you already have voter's ink on your finger.

You will not be allowed to participate in the elections:

- If you refuse to temporarily remove a facemask for identification when presenting your ID card or the passport of the citizen of Georgia;
- If you refuse to mark with indelible ink.

In the polling booth:

- Circle one of your preferred electoral candidates in the ballots.
- If you have spoiled the ballot paper, request a new one from the chairperson of the election commission.
- Voters have a right to ask for assistance in the secret polling booth of any person other than a member of the election commission, a candidate, a representative of the electoral candidate, media or observer if they cannot mark the ballot paper independently

After leaving the polling booth:

- Place the folded ballot in the envelope;
- Place the envelope in the ballot box;
- Leave the individual pen in a special container;
- Leave the polling station after casting your vote;
- Use hand sanitiser when leaving.
