

INFORMATION FOR VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES

Blind voters will receive special braille-enabled ballots to vote independently.

Visually impaired voters will get a magnifying glass to fill in the ballots independently.

Wheelchair-bound voters will have access to the polling booths adapted for wheelchair users.

Deaf and hard of hearing voters can apply to a sign language support employee to get information about the voting procedure after registering on the CEC website.
